HOMEWORK

- 1. Please read the ਮੂਲ ਮੰਤਰ of Japji Sahib <u>five times</u> everyday until next class (15 times before next class). Don't forget to log it in your reading logs (at the back of the book)!
- 2. Please write the following notes in your notebooks once everyday (3 times before next class):
- 96: 9 is pronounced as ik not ek
- ਓ: is pronounced as <u>owan</u> (ਅੰ)
 - o not om or o-ang
- ਸਤਿਨਾਮੁ: pronounce this word with an adhak (ਸ`) as in ਸੱਤਨਾਮ
- ਨਿਰਭਉ : ਨਿਰ = without ਭਉ = fear
 - o this means Vaheguru Jee is without fear.
 - We need to be careful not to say ਭਾਉ



- ਭਾਉ = love
- o Is Vaheguru jee without love? No!
- ਅਜੂਨੀ: ਅ is a ਮੁਕਤਾ। It sounds like uh, not <u>aa</u>
- ਸੈਭੰ: this is pronounced as saibhan(ਅੰ)
 - o there is no <u>G</u> sound.
- ਗੁਰਪ੍ਰਸਾਦਿ: this is pronounced Gur**pra**saad, not Gur**par**saad
 - there is no G sound.
 - Do not pronounce а я, read it as a я!
- ਜੁਗਾਦਿ : pronounce this word with an ਅੱas in ਜੁੱਗਾਦਿ
- ਹੈ ਭੀ ਸਚੁ: ਹੈ and ਭੀ are two separate words, so we pronounce them separately
- ਨਾਨਕ: do not pronounce this as ਨਾਨਿਕ or ਨਾਨੱਕ, say it softly
