#### ADHAK WORDS – ਅੱਧਕ ਵਾਲੇ ਸਬਦ

Shape: It looks like a half circle with an opening at the top (smiley face/basket)

Location: It appears above and between 2 letters

**Sound effect**: It stresses the following/next letter (some key phrases Uncle and Auntie Jee used: it forces us to break/stop after saying the second letter, it tells us to make a sudden stop)

## MUKTA WORDS – ਮੁਕਤੇ ਵਾਲੇ ਸ਼ਬਦ 3 Important Rules – ਤਿੰਨ ਜ਼ਰੂਰੀ ਅਸੂਲ

- 1. Mukta words are made by joining or connecting two or more letters.
  - Example: नल, तन्भ, ਹन्भत, ਹन्दवड, नघन्या
- 2. Mukta words **DO NOT** contain any vowel symbols, only letters.
- 3. Mukta words contain a natural, built-in vowel sound between each letter. The vowel sound is the short "u" sound as in the words:
  - fun, sun, run
